Registration and Induction Fees

Participants are required to pay the applicable registration fees as outlined below:

- **Full Registration (Architects):** ₦280,000.00
- **Architectural Firms:** ₦350,000.00
- **Architectural Technologists:** ₦50,000.00

Please note that all fees are **payable prior to the collection of certificates and instruments of practice**, which will be made available at either the Abuja or Lagos ARCON Office—based on your stated preference. The collection date will be communicated in due course.
